

How to get about in Rishikesh by auto-rickshaw

Auto-rickshaws are a reasonable means of transportation and they often pass the main road near the Ashram where the Satsangs will take place. They provide very cheap transportation whether you choose a private one, or join a 'Shared Rickshaw', which transports many passengers. Rickshaws usually run until 9.00 pm. If you plan to stay out late, make sure you arrange a vehicle in advance.

Rickshaw prices can be found below:

Lakshman Jhula to Ram Jhula or vice-versa	Rs. 10 per passenger on a shared auto-rickshaw
Lakshman Jhula to Rishikesh town or vice-versa	Rs. 15 per passenger on a shared auto-rickshaw
Lakshman Jhula auto-stand to the Ashram or Ashram to Lakshman Jhula auto-stand	Rs. 30 per passenger on a shared auto-rickshaw
Ram Jhula to Swatantranand Ashram or Swatantranand to Ram Jhula	Rs. 20 per passenger on a shared auto-rickshaw

Notes

If an auto-rickshaw is required for Swami Swatantranand Ashram from Lakshman Jhula area (other than from the auto-stand), then generally it has to be hired on a non-sharing basis, which means you have to pay for the full auto-rickshaw.

Full Auto-Rickshaw Rates

From Lakshman Jhula (area other than auto-stand) to Swatantranand Ashram or vice-versa	Rs. 200 - 250
From Lakshman Jhula (auto-stand) to Swatantranand Ashram or vice-versa	Rs. 150 - 200
From Ram Jhula to Swatantranand Ashram or vice-versa	Rs. 100 - 150
From Swatantranand Ashram to Rishikesh town or vice-versa	Rs. 80 - 100
